

RESOLUTION No. 300

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

September 28, 1945

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: That the Southern Pacific Company be granted a revocable permit to construct and operate a drill track across North "B" Street to serve the industrial area North of North "B" Street, midway between 8th and 9th Streets, and to construct and operate a Spur Track across North "B" Street to serve the property along the North line of North "B" Street next east of the City of Sacramento's Incinerator Plant, the center lines of which are as follows:

1. (Drill Track) Beginning at a point on the southerly line of North "B" Street, in the center of proposed drill track and 727.8 feet easterly of the intersection of the center line of 7th Street and the southerly line of North "B" Street; thence across North "B" Street on the arc of a curve concave to the right having a radius of 286.84 feet, the tangent to which makes an angle of 38° 26' with the southerly line of North B Street, a distance of 106.6 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of proposed drill track on the northerly line of North "B" Street;

as shown and described as "Track #2" on blue print filed with application, (Plan designated "Sacramento Division Drawing S917, Drawer 17, Southern Pacific Company") and granted under provision of Section 237 of the Charter of the City of Sacramento, at no expense whatsoever to the City of Sacramento.

2. (Spur Track) Beginning at a point in the center line of present Southern Pacific Company Drill Track in North "B" Street; said point being 368.94 feet east of the center line of 7th Street and 4.00 feet north of the center line of North "B" Street; thence to left through a number 9 turnout making an angle of 6° 21' 35" from the center line of said Drill Track, a distance of 83.90 feet; thence on the arc of a curve concave to the left having a radius of 286.84 feet, an arc distance of 104.94 feet to the north line of North "B" Street;

as shown and described as the "Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Lines, Sacramento, Proposed Track Crossing No. A-90.717 C across North B Street, dated February 3rd, 1944, Sacramento Division Drawing S 939, Drawer 17", at no expense whatsoever to the City of Sacramento; provided, however, that upon the issuance of the permit herein and as a condition thereof:

1. That the Southern Pacific Company grant to the County of Sacramento a strip of land 30 feet in width, extending from a point opposite 5th Street easterly to the property of Bercut-Richards Packing Company; said strip being deemed necessary for widening of North "B" Street.
2. That in the event it is deemed advisable to pave North "B" Street, that the Southern Pacific Company agree to pave between their tracks and for a distance of two (2) feet beyond the rails.

SECTION 2: Resolution No. 210, passed by the City Council of the City of Sacramento on April 27, 1945, is hereby repealed.
