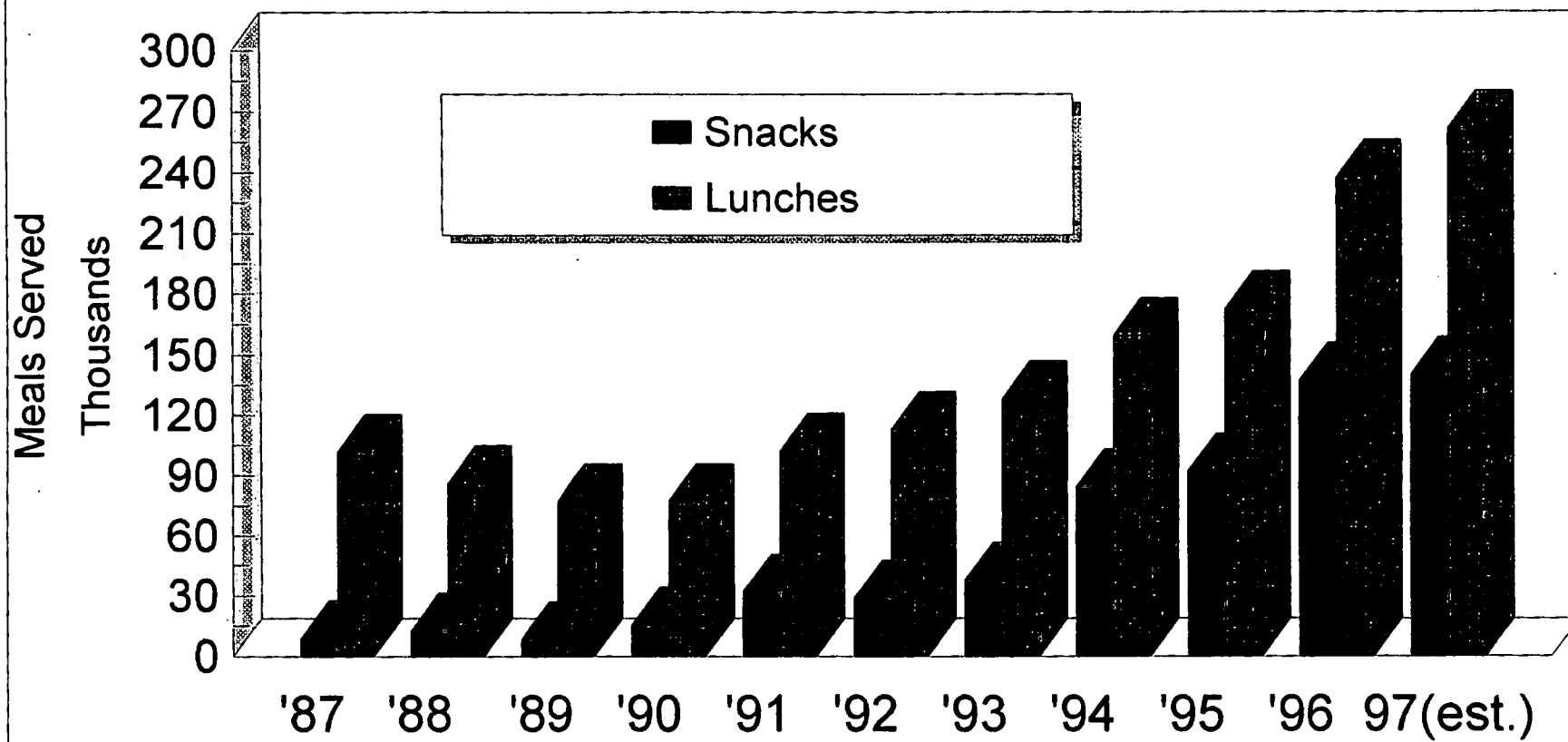

- Three vendors provided meals: Del Paso Heights School District, Elk Grove Unified School District and Elverta School District.
- Federal reimbursement will be approximately \$645,000, an increase of \$47,000.

Sacramento's Summer Food Program: A Valuable Resource for Low-Income Families

Free lunches available to children at 110 sites in Sacramento County

Summer is here and the school cafeteria is closed. For thousands of children in Sacramento county, this means the beginning of a long summer without the consistent and nutritious meals usually received through School Breakfast and School Lunch Programs. The Summer Food Service Program is a federally funded child nutrition program designed to meet the nutritional needs of low-income children while school is out of session. The City of Sacramento is administering the program Monday through Friday at 110 sites in Sacramento County this summer. Sites are operated at churches, apartment complexes, community centers and parks and are usually run completely by volunteers.

Although this is a valuable resource to children with limited family incomes, this program is very underutilized. Last year, over 5,000 children per day received free nutritious meals, but this was less than 10 percent of the children that could have benefited from this program.

"This summer, our goal is to feed 6,000 children per day, a 20% increase over last year. Now more than ever, this program is vital to maintaining children's health and energy through the long summer," said Janet Jewell, director of the program for the City of Sacramento, Neighborhood Services.

Families can find the closest Summer Food Service Program sites by calling InfoLine Sacramento at 498-1000.

Lunches will be served at Woodbine Park on Wednesday, June 25 from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Woodbine Park is located at the corner of 24th Street and 52nd Avenue in Sacramento. From Sacramento take 99 South to 47th Avenue. Go west on 47th Avenue to 24th Street. Go South on 24th Street 5 blocks to Woodbine Park.

The Summer Food Service Program is a federally funded child nutrition program designed to meet the nutritional needs of low-income children while school is out of session. The City's Neighborhood Services Department operates the summertime program Monday through Friday at sites located throughout Sacramento County. Children receive free lunches and snacks at sites sponsored by churches, apartment complexes, community centers and parks. These sites are usually coordinated by community volunteers and agencies around the county.

"We are pleased to see Councilmember Kerth take time out of his busy schedule to learn about this valuable program since so many of the children in his district are benefiting from it," said

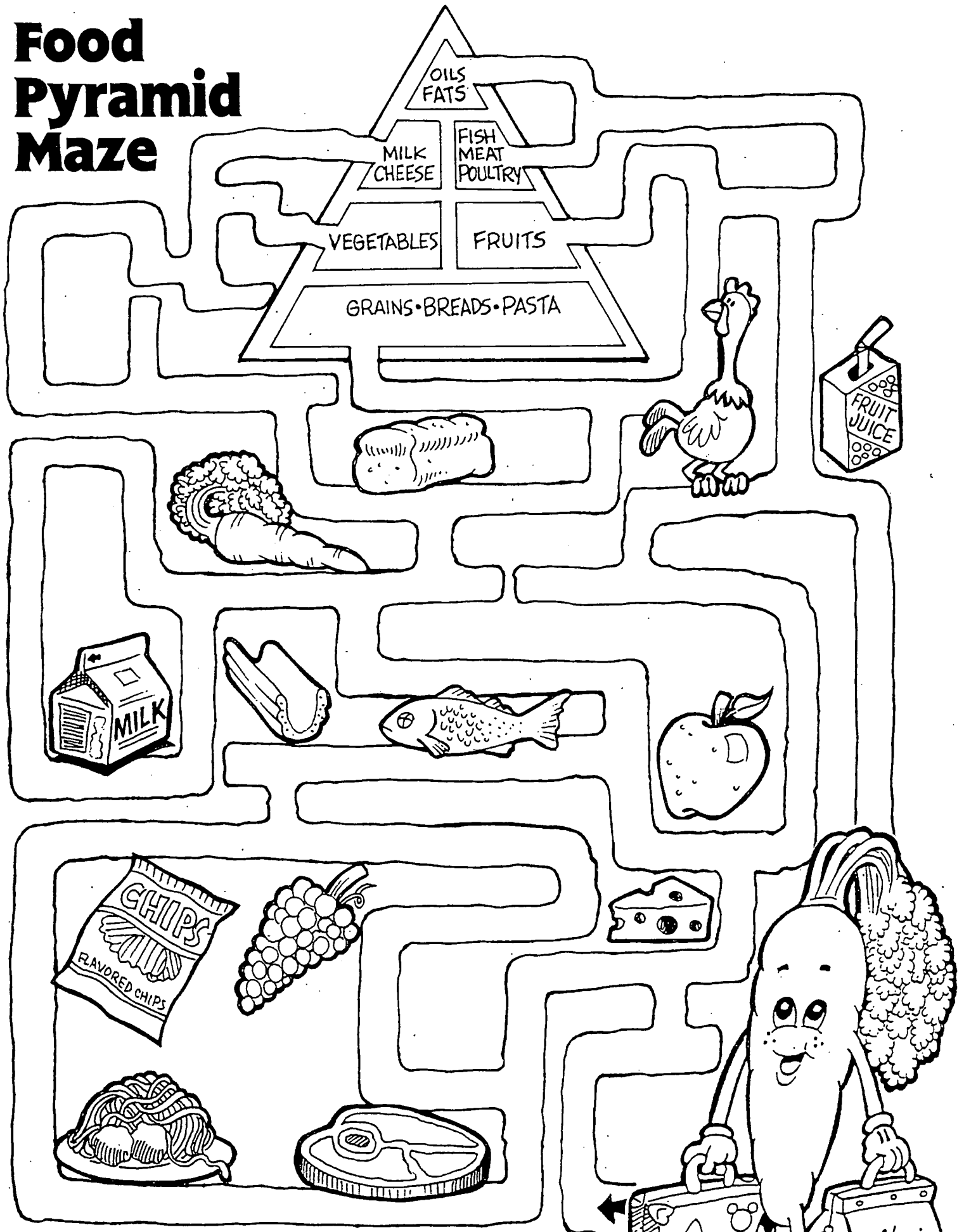

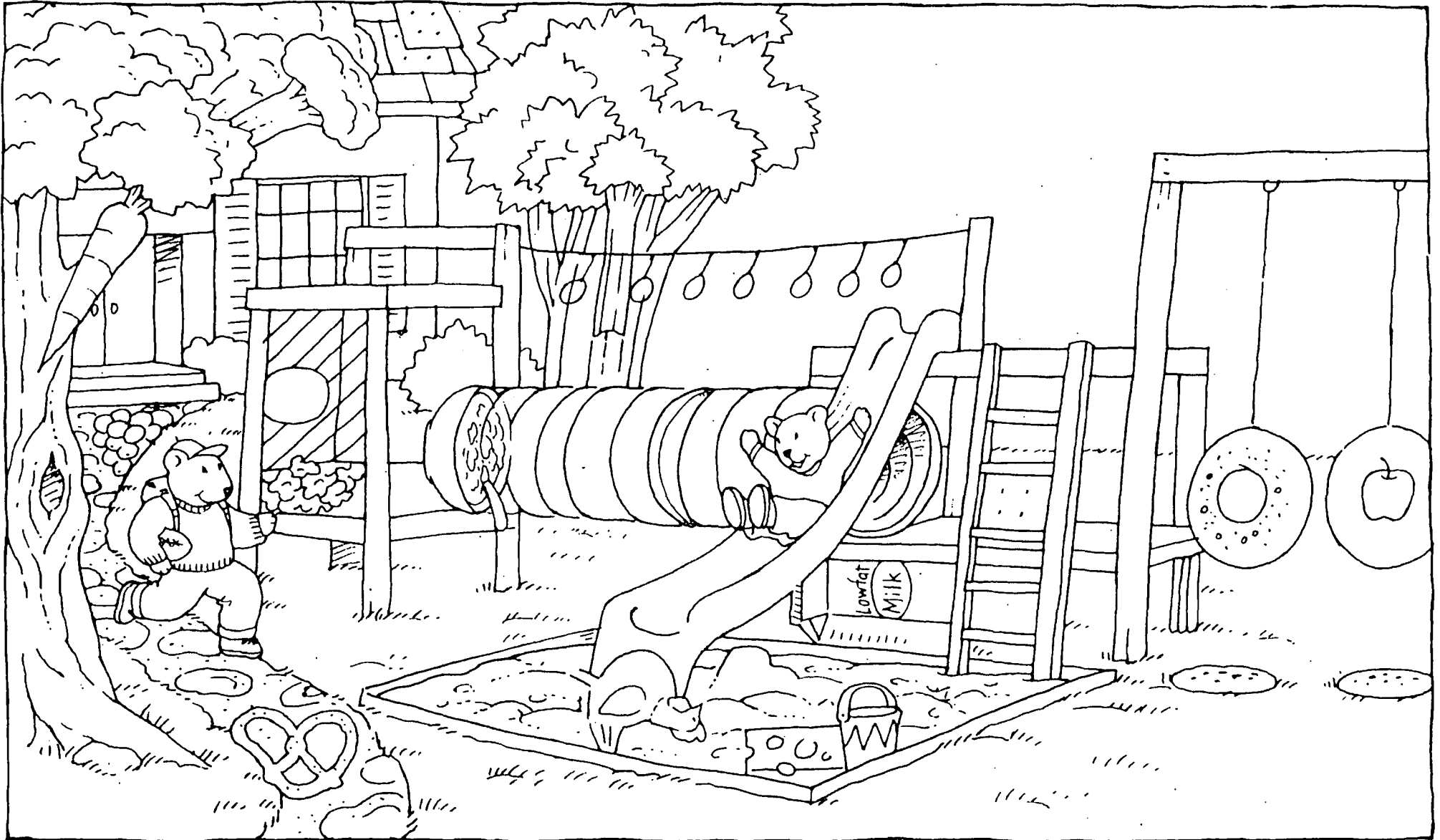
Food Pyramid Maze
