

ORDINANCE NO. 2009, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1957, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1957, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER AND APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1957.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the revenues of the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1957, amounts sufficient to meet the expenditure requirements of the City of Sacramento, a municipal corporation, in the amounts and for the purposes as set forth in the budget submitted May 6, 1957, by the City Manager for the fiscal year 1957-1958 and as determined and adopted by the City Council.

SECTION 2: This ordinance, being one appropriating money necessary for the operation of the Municipal Government for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 1957, is hereby made an emergency measure, to take effect July 1, 1957, as provided for by the City Charter.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk shall publish this ordinance once within ten days after passage in the official newspaper of said City of Sacramento.
