**SUBJECT: Proposed Solid Waste Fee Adjustments for 1989-90**

**SUMMARY**

This report recommends the adoption of rate increases in fees for the solid waste services in fiscal year 1989-90 to be effective July 1, 1989. It is recommended that residential and commercial can rates be increased 9% and that commercial and residential bin rates be increased between 0% and 5%.

**BACKGROUND**

The Solid Waste Fund is an enterprise fund which is financially responsible for the activities of collecting and disposing of solid waste, sweeping streets, and abating litter throughout the City. These functions are performed by the operational units of Refuse Collection, Garden Refuse, Street Sweeping, and Landfill Operations. The enterprise fund resources are supplied by two primary sources: Refuse collection fees and the Lawn and Garden Excise Tax. Since the Lawn and Garden Excise Tax is fixed, all cost increases associated with the lawn and garden program are included in the refuse collection fees. The current cost to provide lawn and garden service to a customer with 90-gallon service is \$5.68 a month, while the Lawn and Garden Tax remains at \$2.00 a month.

In October 1986, staff presented to the Budget and Finance Committee the results of a comprehensive review of the Solid Waste Fees. The report indicated that all fees were sufficient to cover basic cost of garbage collection and disposal service. However, most residential can fees were not enough to cover the cost of the subsidy for garden refuse pickup, street sweeping, neighborhood cleanup, special weekend cleanups, code enforcement assistance, household hazardous waste collection, and disabled exemptions. Correspondingly, other fees carried a disproportionate burden to cover the revenue shortfall.

The October 1986, the report recommended that fees be adjusted over several years to gradually reflect an equitable distribution of costs. The 1987-88 and 1988-89 solid waste fees followed these guidelines by assigning fee increases to those residential services which were underfunded while holding constant the fees for fully funded commercial services. The only remaining category of commercial services that continues to subsidize residential can rates are the residential bins. It is recommended that fees on these bins remain constant. Residential and commercial can rates are proposed to be increased by 9% and commercial bins by 5%.

The 9% rate increase for residential and commercial cans is composed of the following:

The total charge for garden refuse collection to 90 gallon customers is just \$4.08 versus a cost of \$5.68. This difference is subsidized primarily through residential bin customers. This imbalance between rates and costs has existed for several years. Residential bins are currently subsidizing other services by \$950,000. The proposed rate increases will reduce this subsidy by \$200,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

The monthly effect of the proposed fee adjustments for the "typical" residential can services is shown below:

The proposed fee structure for all rates is identified in the attached Exhibit A.


The proposed increases in the solid waste service fees is expected to generate \$1,527,000 in additional revenue to the Solid Waste Fund. Total revenue from the solid waste service fees is projected to be \$19,846,000. This figure is reflected in the revenue schedule in the proposed budget.


**RECOMMENDATION**

## RESOLUTION OF FINDINGS ON INCREASED SOLID WASTE COLLECTION FEES

WHEREAS, the Joint Transportation and Community Development/Budget and Finance Committee has held a public hearing on solid waste fees on June 7, 1989, at which staff made a presentation including a report and at which public testimony was heard and said committee recommended adoption of an increased solid waste residential can fee schedule, and

WHEREAS, the City Council on June 27, 1989, at a regular public council meeting, received the following information:

- (1) A staff report on the proposed increased solid waste residential can fees;
- (2) Oral presentation by City staff;
- (3) Public testimony from interested parties.

NOW THEREFORE, based on this data and all information part of the public record on this matter, the City Council makes the following finding to comply with Government Code Section 210809(b)8 to establish that the passing of the increased solid waste fees of even date herewith serves the following purposes:

- (1) The solid waste fees will provide funds to meet operating expenses.
- (2) The solid waste fees will permit the generation of necessary cash flow to finance maintenance of the collection and disposal system and meet financial reserves requirements.
- (3) The solid waste fees will permit the purchase of necessary equipment for the solid waste collection and disposal system.
- (4) The solid waste fees are essential as a source of funds for capital projects necessary to maintain solid waste collection and disposal system.

NOW THEREFORE, based on this information and the public words, the Council of the City of Sacramento makes the specific finding contained herein as well as all other matters in the public record as its basis for the resolution establishing the fees passed on even date herewith.
