Summary:

The Street Services Division, Signals and Lighting section, has a nonprofessional services agreement for Maintenance of Street Lighting (re-lamping). It was advertised and bid in June 2005. This agreement for an annual amount of \$72,528 expires June 30, 2006. In exhibit A, section 4, there is an option to extend with a minimum annual increase of two percent (2%). Staff recommends the first annual extension.

Background Information:

Bids were received and award was made to Jackson Electric for Maintenance of Street Lighting (re-lamping) in June 2005. This agreement for an annual amount of \$72,528

expires June 30, 2006. In exhibit A, section 4, there is an option to extend with a minimum annual increase of two percent (2%). Work performance has been good and there is still a need for night contract work.
