The Fleet Management Division will be unable to complete the bid process and issue purchase orders for the following 1985-86 approved equipment replacements prior to July 1, 1986.

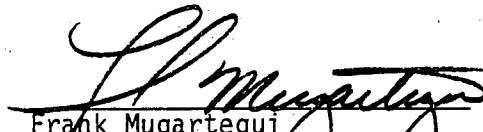

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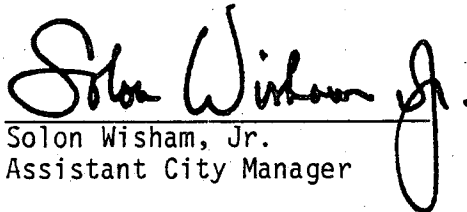
It is requested that the Committee approve this request and include the specified equipment replacements in the 1986-87 Fleet Management Budget.
