AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE LEONARDO DA VINCI SCHOOL DETENTION BASIN 26 PROJECT (PN: WI 71)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Master Drainage Plan Study for Basin 26 (September 2000) concluded the existing storm drainage system does not meet the City's standard of providing 10 or 100 year flood protection. The study's recommended alternative included constructing several detention basins and installing larger storm drainage pipes throughout the basin to meet the City's standard for drainage system performance.
- B. The Leonardo Da Vinci School Detention Basin 26 project utilizes the existing three acre playfield at the school and includes the installation of larger storm drainage pipe along 23rd and 24th Avenues, Larson Way, and 23rd Street. The detention basin will be fully irrigated and landscaped with arena seating, iron fencing, benches, picnic tables, plus new soccer and baseball fields.
- C. The project was advertised and seven bids were received and opened on June 28, 2007. Sierra National Construction was the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Leonardo Da Vinci School Detention Basin 26 project (PN: WI 71) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Sierra National Construction for an amount not to exceed \$2,260,720.
- Section 2. The transfer of \$172,000 from the Sump 33 Detention Basin project (PN WJ96, Fund 425-500-WJ96-4820) to the Leonardo Da Vinci School Detention Basin 26 project (PN: WI71, Fund 425-500-WI71-4820) is approved.
