

RESOLUTION No. 13

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of
FEBRUARY 4, 1926

WHEREAS, that certain deed dated the 3rd day of February, 1926, was executed by Frank Hickman, Chris R. Jones and Effie C. Jones, Wilbur F. Brand and Emeline S. Brand to the City of Sacramento, conveying to the said City of Sacramento, a right-of-way, underground, through and across the following described property situated in said City of Sacramento and more particularly described as follows:

A right of way for the purpose of laying and maintaining water pipes, together with the right to enter upon said property for the purpose of repairing and removing the same, underground, through and across the Easterly Two (2) feet of Lots Numbered 1, 45, 57, 69, 73, 75, 120, 132, 144 and 150; and underground, through and across the Westerly Two (2) feet of Lots Numbered 2, 44, 56, 68, 72, 76, 119, 131, 143 and 149; and underground, through and across the Easterly Three (3) feet of Lots Numbered 37, 38 and 113 of Boulevard Terrace Subdivision No. 1, according to the official map or plat thereof filed for record in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.

Also a right of way for the purpose of laying and maintaining water pipes and sewer pipes, together with the right to enter upon said property for the purpose of repairing and removing the same, underground, through and across the Easterly Five (5) feet of Lot Numbered 112 of Boulevard Terrace Subdivision No. 1 according to the official map or plat thereof on file in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council that foregoing deed be and the same is hereby accepted, the City Clerk being directed to attach a certified copy hereof to the said Deed and record same in office of the County Recorder of the County of Sacramento, State of California.
