RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE
BODY UNDER "SPECIAL ASSESSMENT, INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION
AND MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2892

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection herewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving the Alley between X and Y Streets from the Easterly line of Stockton Boulevard to the Westerly line of 45th Street by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; installing cast-iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified clay sewer pipe; installing vitrified clay pipe sewer; installing concrete protective covering on vitrified clay sewer pipe where shown on Plan; installing vitrified clay sewer pipe Wyes; constructing concrete manholes complete with cast-iron curbs and covers; installing expansion joints removing asphaltic concrete pavement, concrete slab and trees where shown on plan; grading and constructing an hydraulic concrete pavement constructing concrete retaining wall where shown on plan.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 2822(c) reference is hereby made to that certain plat or map on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in Proceedings No. 2892 which indicates by a boundary line the territory to be included in the Assessment District and which said map or plat is endorsed "Approved by the City Council of the City of Sacramento this 20th day of December, 19 51;" signed "Mayor" Bert E. Geisreiter.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is the "Improvement Act of 1911", approved April 7, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; with bonds to be issued as authorized under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Section 3 of the "Special Assessment, Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931", approved June 8, 1931, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.
