SUBJECT: RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

North 10th and Vine Streets. Council District 1.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution prohibiting parking during certain hours on North 10th and Vine Streets.

SUMMARY:

The City Police Department has requested that all parking be prohibited on North 10th and Vine Streets during the nighttime hours 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. (Exhibit A). This area has been the location of much criminal activity. Prohibiting parking will reduce the number of vehicles in the area and provide the Police Department with an additional tool to use in addressing area problems.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The area of North 10th and Vine Streets was identified as a problem area by the Problem Oriented Police Officers (POP Officers) and has been a project area since 1993.
- There has been more than eighteen hundred calls for service originating from this area since 1993. Hundreds of arrests have been made for offenses ranging from solicitation for prostitution to sales of drugs.
- The amount of enforcement action and time spent on deterring criminal behavior has been taxing on police resources and has had only limited success.
- Discarded syringes and condoms are found daily at an elementary school on Vine Street and at nearby businesses.
- Prohibiting parking from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. will help deter the type of criminal behavior that this area has become known for.
- Area businesses support the removal of nighttime parking.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking restrictions is estimated to be \$2,500 for the installation of regulatory signing. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement. It is also consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.07.103 which provides for the removal of parking during certain hours.



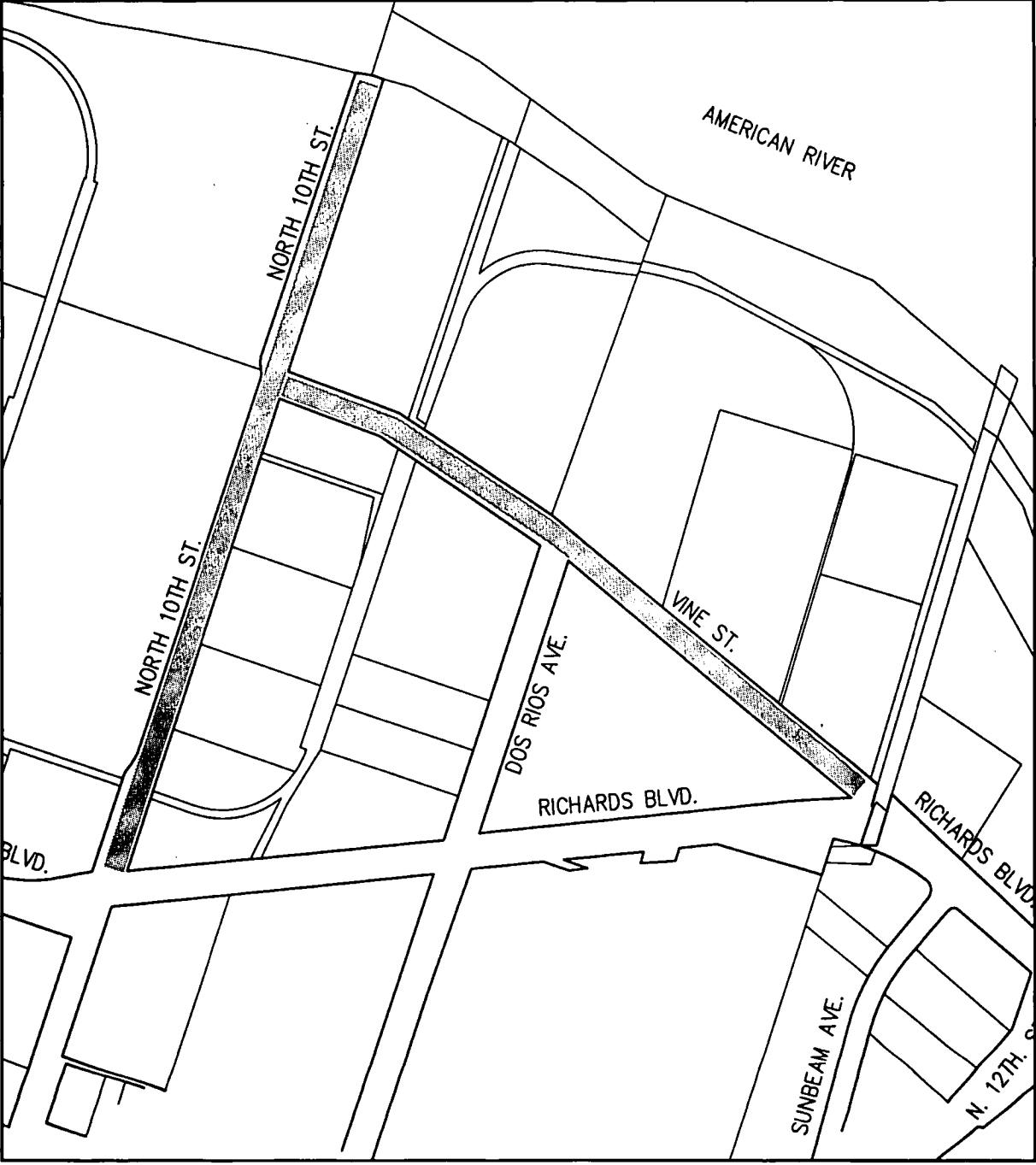

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING DURING CERTAIN HOURS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 25.07.103 of the Sacramento City code when authorized signs are in place giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park on the days indicated on such signs, between the hours specified on such signs, upon any of the streets described in resolutions duly adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following streets shall have parking prohibited from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

- North 10 Street, both sides from Richards Boulevard to Vine Street.
- North 10 Street, east side, from Vine Street to the American River levee.
- Vine Street, north side, from Richards Boulevard to North 10th Street.
- Vine Street, south side, from Richards Boulevard west 200 feet.
- Vine Street, south side, from Dos Rios Street to North 10th Street.
