

RESOLUTION No. 210

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

June 4, 1943

RE STATUS OF OPERATORS AT CENTRAL FIRE ALARM STATION.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 618, adopted April 29, 1937, the City Council created the office and employment of operators of the Central Fire Alarm System at a salary range of \$140.00 to \$175.00 per month, which has since been increased to \$180.00; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Chief of the Fire Department that these operators should be regular members of the Fire Department and that any vacancies in the present personnel should be filled by him, with the consent of the City Manager, from the regular members of the Fire Department,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that from and after July 1, 1943, said operators shall be members of the regular Fire Department of the City of Sacramento and vacancies in the personnel of said Central Fire Alarm System shall be filled by the Chief of the Fire Department, with the consent of the City Manager, from the regular Fire Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Civil Service Board be requested to give the present operators an examination to qualify them as regular members of the Fire Department.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Resolution No. 618, adopted April 29, 1937, be and the same is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event of an emergency caused by shortage of firemen who are competent to be so assigned, other persons, including women, may be employed in said System.
