

ORDINANCE NO. 989, FOURTH SERIES


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PURCHASE ELECTION SUPPLIES FOR THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD NOVEMBER 2, 1943, WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The proper purchasing authorities of the City of Sacramento are hereby authorized and directed to purchase for and on behalf of the City of Sacramento necessary election supplies for the use of precinct officers of election at the Regular Municipal Election to be held in the City of Sacramento on the 2nd day of November, 1943, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately, such emergency existing because there is not sufficient time to advertise for bids and award a contract for the furnishing of such supplies before the holding of said election, and it further appearing that no saving can be accomplished in the purchase of said supplies even though bids were asked for.
