
A RESOLUTION CONTINUING THE COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS SET FORTH IN THAT CERTAIN MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE INTERNATIONAL UNION OF OPERATING ENGINEERS STATIONARY LOCAL 39, AFL-CIO

WHEREAS, on July 3, 1979, the City Council adopted a memorandum of understanding between the City and the International Union of Operating Engineers, Stationary Local 39, AFL-CIO (Operations and Maintenance, Office and Technical, Professional, and Supervisory Units); and


WHEREAS, that memorandum of understanding as amended expires on June 26, 1981; and

WHEREAS, the City and the International Union of Operating Engineers Stationary Local 39, AFL-CIO have not yet reached agreement on a new memorandum of understanding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO that the City Manager is authorized and directed to continue to provide to employees in the Operations and Maintenance, Office and Technical, Professional, and Supervisory Units the compensation and benefits set forth in the said memorandum of understanding as amended, which expires June 26, 1981, until further action by the City Council.
