RESOLUTION GIVING THE NAME OF "MEMORIAL DRIVE" TO A ROADWAY IN WILLIAM LAND PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Sacramento, through the Park Department is about to plant a large number of trees, procured by the Veterans of Foreign Wars from different battle field in France upon which the American army was engaged during the World War, along the main drive-way of William Land Park from Riverside Road to Freeport Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to designate and name said drive-way as "MEMORIAL DRIVE" in memory of the heroic dead of the City of Sacramento;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the main drive-way of William Land Park, extending from Riverside Road to Freeport Boulevard, be, and the same is hereby designated and named as "MEMORIAL DRIVE".
