
## SUMMARY



SUBJECT: Naming the Future Softball Complex at Del Paso Regional Park  
"Sacramento Softball Complex" and Amending the City/County  
Joint Agreement

### SUMMARY

This report recommends that the soon to be developed softball complex at Del Paso Regional Park be named the Sacramento Softball Complex. This report further recommends amending the City/County Joint Agreement to reflect the City's and the County's increased contribution to the project.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Del Paso Park Sports Complex, a cooperative City and County venture, will include four lighted softball diamonds to serve the estimated 2,650 City and County softball teams; bleacher seating to accommodate 7,000 persons; warm-up area, tot lot, and picnic areas; and support services. An Agreement between the City and the County providing for joint planning, development, operations, and maintenance, was executed in October 1984. Under the terms of this 28-year agreement, the City and the County shall each contribute to the financing of this project.

Given the cooperative nature of this venture, naming of this facility should represent both the City and the County. City and County staff recommend that this facility be named the Sacramento Softball Complex. The Greater Sacramento Softball Association, the leading community organization in the fund raising efforts for this facility, supports this name.

In accordance with the City/County Joint Agreement, a joint City/County grant application for \$1 million was submitted under the California Park and Recreation Facilities Act of 1984, Regional Competitive Grant Program. Under

this grant program, \$599,000 was awarded for construction of the sports complex; \$401,000 less than the original application. This decrease in anticipated state funding must be offset by increased contributions from both the City and the County. The City's increased obligation is being met through a successful application for a \$236,884 block grant under the Roberti-Z'berg Urban Open Space and Recreation Program. The County has appropriated an additional \$200,000 towards this project. It is necessary to amend the City/County Joint Agreement to reflect this increased City and County contribution.

The County of Sacramento approved the naming of the Complex and amendment to the Joint Agreement at their June 11, 1985, meeting.

FINANCIAL DATA

The total sports complex project is estimated at \$2,561,000. Overall funding is proposed as follows:
