SUBJECT: Regulating the Parking of Horse-Drawn Vehicles in Old  
Sacramento

#### SUMMARY

This report recommends that parking and/or storing horse-drawn vehicles on street be prohibited.

#### BACKGROUND

The attached proposed ordinance provides for regulating zones designated exclusively for loading and unloading passengers from horse-drawn vehicles, restricting parking or storing horse-drawn vehicles beyond 15 minutes. The City will be providing an area exclusively for the storage of horse-drawn vehicles in Lot Q (Front Street south of Capitol Mall). This will prevent wagons being stored on-street and obstructing traffic operations and store-front visibility.




RECOMMENDATION



# ORDINANCE NO.

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING STOPPING AND  
PARKING HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLES IN THE OLD  
SACRAMENTO HISTORIC DISTRICT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

## Section 1

Section 25.128 is hereby added to the Sacramento City Code as follows:

Section 25.128 Regulation of stopping and parking horse-drawn vehicles in the Old Sacramento Historic District.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, red zones in the Old Sacramento Historic District shall be restricted to stopping and parking horse-drawn vehicles for the purposes of loading and unloading passengers or resting animals, not to exceed 15 minutes.
