**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE OF BID, AND CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AWARD TO M & M ELECTRIC AND FUND TRANSFER OF \$35,000 FROM MAJOR STREET CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCY RESERVE TO THE ELDER CREEK AND RING-RANCHO ADOBE DRIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION PROJECT (PN:SM03)**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

The Elder Creek and Ring-Rancho Adobe Drive Traffic Signal Installation Project is located in Council District No. 6.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

This report recommends that City Council:

- Approve plans and specifications;
- Accept low bid of M & M Electric in the amount of \$148,958;
- Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for Elder Creek and Ring-Rancho Adobe Drive Traffic Signal Installation Project (PN:SM03);
- Adopt the attached resolution appropriating and transferring \$35,000 from Major Street Construction contingency reserve.

**SUMMARY:**

This project involves installation of a traffic signal at Elder Creek and Ring-Rancho Adobe Drive including the installation of curb ramps at the corners. In addition, the work includes connecting the existing signal interconnect cables to provide sequencing of the existing traffic signals along Elder Creek Road.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

None.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

This intersection was first placed on the signal priority list in 1991 at the direction of the District 6 Council Member. This location currently ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in the 1999-2000 Transportation Programming Guide. The project was authorized in the 1999/2000 Capital Improvement Program with a construction estimate of \$124,000. Bids were received and opened on June 13, 2001 and contract award to M & M Electric is recommended.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The current project budget for the Elder Creek and Ring-Rancho Adobe Drive Traffic Signal (PN:SM03) is \$150,000. Approval of the \$35,000 transfer from Major Street Construction contingency reserve will increase the project budget to \$185,000. The available unobligated balance after the transfer will be \$152,280, which is sufficient to execute the proposed contract with M&M Electric.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

In accordance with the State Guidelines for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the Neighborhoods, Planning, and Development Services Department, Environmental Services Section, has determined that the proposed project will not have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15301 (b) and Section 15303 (d). A notice of Exemption has been filed with the County Recorder's Office.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


The action requested herein is consistent with Sacramento City Code, Title 3.


**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

2. The low bid of M & M Electric is accepted and the City Manager is authorized to sign and execute the contract with the M & M Electric in the amount not to exceed \$148,958.
3. The 2001/02 Capital Improvement Program is amended by transferring \$35,000 from Major Street Construction contingency reserve to the Elder Creek and Ring-Rancho Adobe Drive Traffic Signal (PN:SM03).
4. The budget be adjusted to reflect the above as follows:
