RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF LEGISLATIVE BODY  
UNDER DIVISION 4 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, THE  
"SPECIAL ASSESSMENT INVESTIGATION, LIMITATION AND  
MAJORITY PROTEST ACT OF 1931" NO. 2574

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Sacramento that certain improvements are proposed to be done and made within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district hereinafter described.

In connection therewith, said City Council hereby finds and determines as follows, to-wit:

1. That the nature of the proposed improvement and the location and extent thereof consists of improving S STREET from the easterly line of 39th Street to the sewer in place in the Alley 1st East of 39th Street by removing and disposing of all refuse and surplus materials; grading and constructing concrete curbs, gutters and sidewalks; installing cast iron gutter drains and connecting same to sewer system with vitrified ironstone sewer pipe; constructing vitrified ironstone pipe sewer; constructing a concrete manhole complete with cast iron curb and cover; grading and constructing an asphaltic concrete pavement  $5\frac{1}{2}$  inches in thickness.

2. The boundaries of the district of lands proposed to be specially assessed to pay the costs and expenses of such proposed work and improvement are generally defined as follows, to-wit:

Bounded on the North by the North lines of Lots 19, 20 and 22 of Williamson Tract (as the same is shown on the official plat thereof filed in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder);

On the East by the West line of the Alley 1st East of 39;

On the South by the South lines of Lots 15, 17 and 18 of said Williamson Tract;

On the West by the West lines of Lots 15, 17, 20 and 22 of said Williamson Tract.

3. That the amount and portion of the cost of such proposed improvement proposed to be paid by the City of Sacramento from any source other than special assessments upon benefited property is nil.

4. The statute under which it is proposed to conduct proceedings for the proposed improvement is the "Improvement Act of 1911," approved April 7, 1911, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; with bonds to be issued as authorized under the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915," approved June 11, 1915, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto, said bonds to bear interest at the rate of four (4%) per cent per annum; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare for this Council a written Report upon the proposed improvement, such Report to contain all the information required by Section 3 of the "Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931," approved June 8, 1931, and the several acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto.
