SUMMARY:

- The construction contract for the Folsom Boulevard and State University Drive East Extension Project was awarded to Martin Brothers Construction, Inc. on February 29, 1999 in the amount of \$157,712. Change Order No. 2 will compensate the contractor for balancing quantities and accommodating field conflicts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Approval of Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$12,810.95 will compensate the contractor for balancing quantities and accommodating other minor field conflicts.
- Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$11,696.31 included removing unsuitable material and adding sub-base material for street section.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The unobligated fund balance for this project, as of May 30, 2000, is \$43,904, which is sufficient to fund Change Order No. 2.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning Division, Environmental Services Section finds that no significant effects on the environment would result from this project. The Negative Declaration was approved by the City Council on January 25, 2000, and it was filed with the County Clerk on January 26, 2000.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:
