SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION, TUESDAY, DECEMBER 8, 1942.

WHEREAS, forty-two (42) applications were received and Ballots forwarded for Special Municipal Election held in the City of Sacramento on date of December 8, 1942 for the purpose of voting upon an Initiative Ordinance providing for a ten per cent increase in the salaries of the Patrolmen and Sergeants and Firemen, Engineers and Captains of the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, thirty-seven (37) of foregoing Ballots have been returned; and


WHEREAS, four (4) of said Ballots are declared invalid due to the absence of an acknowledgment,
