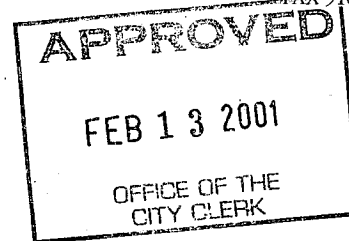

SUMMARY:

The attached resolution grants new Animal Control Officers in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services Division citation authority to enforce specific City Code and state law provisions, consistent with the Animal Control Officer job classification.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Throughout the City, various employee classifications have citation authority to enforce specific sections of the City Code. Within the Department of Public Works, Animal Control Officers, Parking Enforcement Officers, Waste Reduction Coordinators and Traffic Investigators have citation authority.

Chapter 2.12 of the Sacramento City Code gives authority to the City Council to grant citation authority to individual employees. After a job classification is designated by the City Manager as needing citation authority, a resolution granting individual employees citation authority is routinely forwarded to the City Council for approval. It is necessary to update the list of names as personnel changes occur.



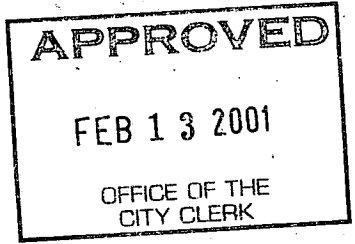
