**SUBJECT:** General Revenue Sharing Funds Proposed Use Hearing

**SUMMARY**

Federal regulations governing the use of General Revenue Sharing Funds require that the City Council hold a public hearing to receive public testimony for proposed uses of Revenue Sharing Funds. The attached report to the City Council recommends that the hearing be held concurrently with the March 3, 1987 City Council meeting. The report also recommends that the fiscal year 1986-87 Revenue Sharing funds be appropriated to offset the City's fire suppression costs.

**RECOMMENDATION**

**SUBJECT:** General Revenue Sharing Funds Proposed Use Hearing

**SUMMARY**

This hearing is required by federal regulations governing the use of General Revenue Sharing Funds. This item was heard by the Budget and Finance Committee on February 24, 1987.

**BACKGROUND**

Federal regulations require a public hearing to receive public testimony for proposed uses of General Revenue Sharing Funds. In prior years this hearing was held as part of the annual budget process. Due to the uncertainty of the amount to be received in FY 1986-87, no Revenue Sharing revenues were considered in the allocation process.

The final portion of the Revenue Sharing entitlement was received in October in the amount of \$926,755. Together with the unappropriated carryover from FY 1985-86 of \$70,494, there is \$997,249 to be expended for any proper City use purpose. In the past the City used the Revenue Sharing entitlement to offset the City's costs in Fire Suppression. Official notice of the required proposed use hearing was published on February 13, 1987.

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the required "budget hearing" on Revenue Sharing uses be held concurrently with the March 3, 1987 City Council meeting. It is further recommended that the City Council adopt attached resolution to offset the City's fire suppression costs.
