SUBJECT: Acceptance of Low Bid, Award of Construction Contract

and Designation of Contracting Officer for Oak Park

Multi Family Housing Project

#### SUMMARY

Attached is a resolution (1) awards the Contract for Construction of the Oak Park 24-unit family housing project located on the north side of 5th Avenue, between 35th and 36th Street to Hunt Construction of Sacramento, Inc., the low bidder; (2) authorizes the Interim Executive Director to enter into a contract with the low bidder on the basis of a designated bid alternate; and (3) designates an Agency Contracting Officer for the project.

#### BACKGROUND .

On May 19, 1981 the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento adopted Resolution No. RA-81-033 which approved Final Plans and Specifications and authorized solicitation of Bids for the Oak Park Multi Family Project.

City of Sacramento building inspection preliminary plan check clearance was received June 15, 1981. Final contract documents were received June 26, 1981 and open, competitive bid advertising began June 29, 1981. Advertising was conducted in accordance with Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency Affirmative Action Plan, as amended, to August 1980. Advertisements were placed in the Sacramento Bee, the Sacramento Union, the Sacramento Observer and El Hispano.

Documents were picked up by twenty-three general contractors. Ten sets were distributed without charge to Builders' Exchanges. Nine bids were received from general contractors, which included one "minority" contractor. All bids met all published bidding requirements. Attached Exhibit A is a summary of all bids received.

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Staff has conducted a preliminary review and determined that the apparent low bidder, Hunt Construction of Sacramento, Inc., is duly licensed as a General Contractor-B, holds a valid Business Tax License in the City of Sacramento and with proposed award of the contract will not exceed their construction bonding capacity.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

On March 11, 1980 the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento adopted Resolution No. 2894 which approved \$1,700,000 Total Estimated Project Costs be funded from Third Year and Fourth Year Project 2-A Tax Increments. Attached Exhibit C summarizes expenditures to date and proposed remaining expenditures.

The bid format allowed for incremental additive alternates in order to provide cost flexibility at the present Award stage. There were four alternates:

Bid A: Base Bid;

Bid B: Adding double glazing;

Bid C: Adding log walls at the tot lot; and

Bid D: Adding sod lawns.

Bid A includes all basic elements of the Project. Bid B adds double glazing to improve sound isolation of the units and improve energy conservation by reducing heat gain through the windows. Bid C adds logs and related improvements in the tot play area. The logs will increase the attractiveness of the play area, centralize play activities and provide lessened maintenance because play will be directed toward the tot lot rather than the adjacent grounds. Bid D adding sodded lawns was included in the event landscaping construction work might be scheduled for periods when grass seeds would have difficulty sucessfully germinating.

Staff is recommending Alternate D not be awarded because landscaping construction will take place during favorable growth periods. The apparent low bidder, Hunt Construction of Sacramento, Inc., submitted the low bid for all alternates (Exhibit B), including the low Base Bid A in the amount of \$1,438,000.

#### VOTE AND RECOMMENDATION OF COMMISSION

At its regular meeting of August 17, 1981 the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Commission adopted a motion recommending adoption of the attached resolution. The votes were as follows:

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#### RECOMMENDATION

#### Gentlemen:

In compliance with your Notice to Contractors and the Instructions to Bidders, the undersigned hereby proposes and agrees to furnish any and all labor, materials, equipment, transportation and services necessary and/or reasonably incidental for the construction and completion of the Oak Park Multi-Family Housing Project, in strict conformance with the drawings, specifications, addenda, and other contract documents as prepared by McGuire, Eatough & Fong, Inc., A.I.A., Architects, 3110 Watt Avenue, Sacramento, California 95821.

#### BID A - BASE BID:

All work necessary to complete construction of twelve (12) onestory duplex buildings including all items of work shown on the drawings and specified. Bid A shall be complete, including all costs for plan checking permits and hook-up fees for connection of the sewer and water systems and any cost or fees required by the Sacramento Municipal Utility District to service the project with electricity. The undersigned further agrees that the Bid Bond or cashier's check shall be held by the Agency and either transacted by the Agency or returned to the Bidder in the manner set forth in the Instructions to Bidders.

The undersigned further agrees to furnish to the Agency at the time of Agreement execution, at no expense to the Agency, Performance and Payment Bonds in amounts set forth in the Instructions to Bidders issued by corporate sureties satisfactory to the Agency, which bonds shall be in the respective forms contained in the Specifications.

The undersigned further agrees to furnish to the Agency at the time of Agreement execution, at no expense to the Agency, Insurance Policies or Certificates as required by the Specifications.

The undersigned agrees, if awarded the Contract, to start work at the site no later than ten (10) calendar days after the date of written notice from the Agency to start construction.


