SUBJECT: APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT OF \$55,000 FOR THE
UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING UPGRADE PROJECT
(PN:SG16)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

Union Pacific Railroad Corridor (see attached map). Council Districts 3,4,5 and 8.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council:

- Adopt the attached resolution appropriating \$55,000 to the Union Pacific Railroad Grade Crossing Upgrade Project (PN:SG16).

SUMMARY:

This project is the second of three phases of grade crossing improvements completed on the Union Pacific Railroad Corridor. An additional appropriation of \$55,000 is required to provide the City's matching share of project costs

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The project was approved and is funded through a Federal Safety Program that provides 90% of project costs. The remaining 10% match must be provided by the City. The work was performed by the Union Pacific Railroad Company and administered by Caltrans.

This project provided various surface, sidewalk, track and signal equipment improvements at 15 railroad crossings within the City.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The total estimated cost for this phase of work is \$150,000. As of April 27, 1998, there was \$1,995 remaining in project funds. A fund appropriation of \$55,000 is required to close out this phase of the project.

ENVIRONMENTAL:

The Union Pacific Railroad Grade Crossing Upgrade Project was cleared environmentally by Caltrans, who is administering the project. No city environmental documentation was required.


POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

Proposed fund appropriations reimbursement agreements and project closeouts are in accordance with Title 58 of the City Code.



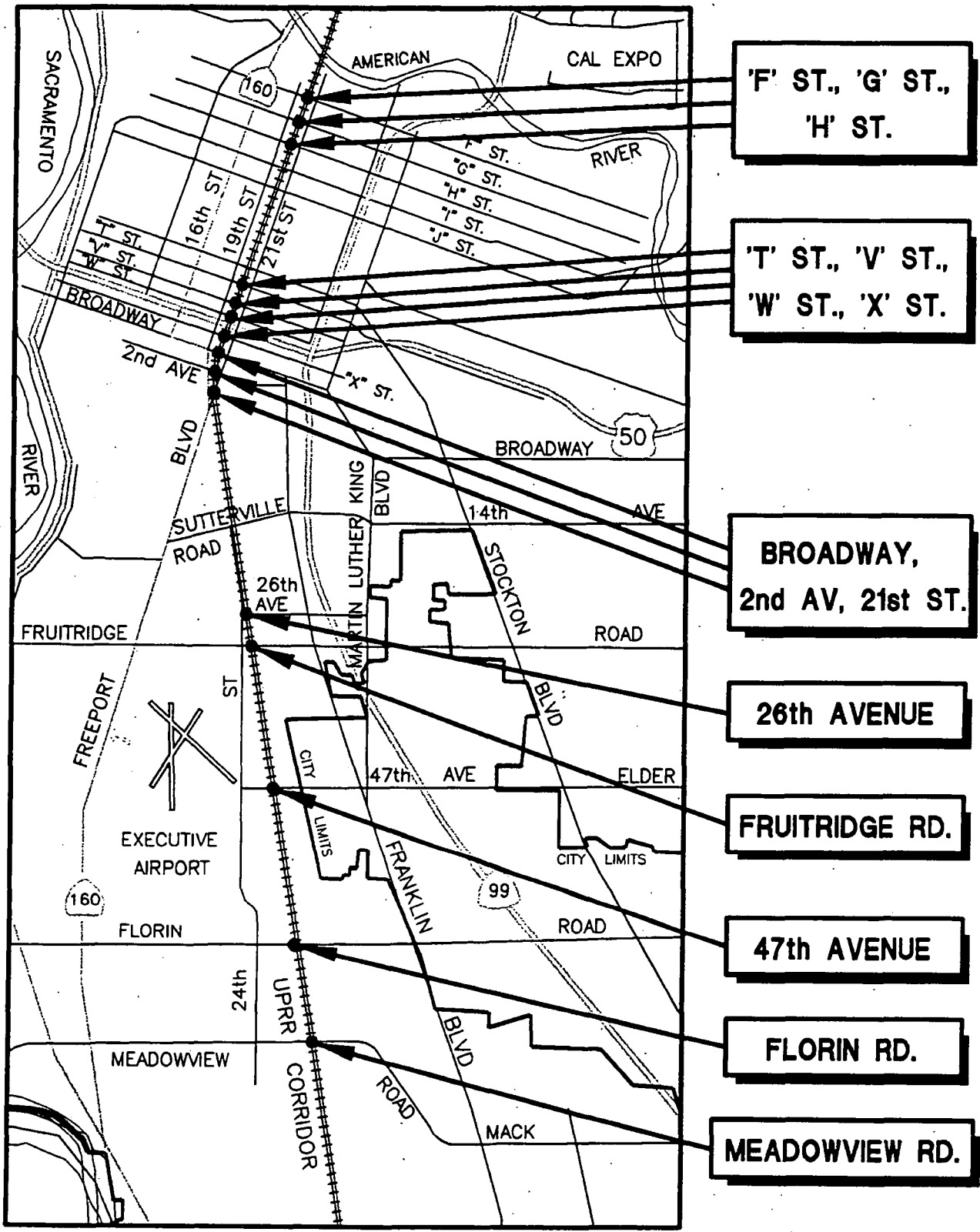
