SUBJECT: Metropolitan Arts Division - Authorization to Submit a Proposal to the City of Sacramento for Comprehensive Employment & Training Act (CETA) Public Service Employment

SUMMARY

This report recommends authorization for the Metropolitan Arts Division to submit a proposal to the City of Sacramento for a contract in the amount of \$72,960 for the purpose of conducting a community artists' program entitled, "Artreach."

BACKGROUND

Since January 1979, the Metro Arts Division has been conducting a CETA Public Service Employment Program. This proposal, if funded, will be the third consecutive contract held by this agency from the City of Sacramento.

The program is designed to provide arts services as a resource to arts organizations, social and educational institutions, the general public, and to encourage unsubsidized employment for the artists providing the services.

To date, there have been approximately 66% of past participants placed in unsubsidized employment.

FINANCIAL DATA

This project will not create needs that cannot be met without continuing CETA support.


RECOMMENDATION


