

**RESOLUTION No. 2149**  
**RESOLUTION APPROVING ASSESSMENT**  
Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

November 25, 1927.

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of the City of Sacramento has heretofore made and issued and filed with the City Clerk an Assessment, together with a Diagram and Engineer's Certificate, to represent the cost and expenses of improving that portion of 65th Street lying west of the center line thereof, from a point 12 feet southerly from the center line of Folsom Boulevard to the center line of 14th Avenue; 61st Street, from the manhole in place on 5th Avenue to a point 8 feet south of the center line of 2nd Avenue; and 2nd Avenue, from the easterly line of 61st Street to the westerly line of 65th Street, in the City of Sacramento, the proceedings for the making of which improvement were initiated by the adoption of Resolution of Intention No. 2149.

WHEREAS, this is the time fixed by the City Clerk for the hearing by this Council upon said Assessment, and it is also the time fixed for the hearing of any appeal to this Council by any person interested in said work or in said Assessment; and

WHEREAS, no appeal has been taken to this Council by any person, and the City Council has heard evidence upon said Assessment and the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto, and is satisfied with the correctness of the same.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that said Assessment, together with the Diagram and Engineer's Certificate attached thereto be and the same are hereby confirmed and approved in all respects as filed.
