Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

April 24, 1942

REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED ZONING

WHEREAS, Sub. 6 of Sec. 24 of Ordinance No. 412, 4.S., provides that if property which has been rezoned is not so used within six months that said property shall automatically revert back to its former zoning classification.

WHEREAS, several properties have not become devoted to such new classifications within said term and have therefore now assumed their status as existed prior to such rezoning,

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has ruled that the reinstatement of all such property must be accomplished by an entirely new procedure,

NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City Council hereby initiates a proceeding for the reinstatement of all properties rezoned by this Council under said subdivision and which have not been accordingly used prior to expiration of the six-month period,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said matter be referred to the City Planning Commission for hearings and recommendation to the City Council.
