

ORDINANCE NO. 1072 FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1060, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 29, 1945, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1945, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER, AND MAKING THIS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE," AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the available funds not heretofore appropriated, the sum of \$2500.00 for the payment of the expenses of VENEREAL DISEASE CONTROL EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN.

SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that public health and safety requires that this program be started immediately.
