RESOLUTION ACCEPTING RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED

WHEREAS, John Sandburg, Minnie E. Sandburg, Louis D. Carlson and Ada H. Carlson have made, executed and delivered to the City of Sacramento a certain Right-of-Way Deed, conveying to the City of Sacramento the following real property in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, bounded and particularly described as follows:

RIVER PARK PROPERTY:

A strip of land five (5') feet in width the southerly boundary of which is described as follows:

Commencing at 1 1/2" iron pipe monument stamped "R.E. 2765" from which monument the Northwest corner of "Norristown" bears S. 67° 12' 15" W. 643.03 ft. distant; thence N. 67° 41' E. 2815.55 ft. along the southerly boundary of River Park Tract to the southeast corner of said tract as shown on the file map of River Park Tract, City of Sacramento, filed in the office of the County Recorder on July 11, 1946.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the said Right-of-Way Deed be, and the same is, hereby accepted; the City Clerk being directed to attach certified copy hereof to the said Right-of-Way Deed, and record same in the office of the Sacramento County Recorder.
