

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-0076

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 12, 2019

Agreement: Kaiser Foundation Hospitals Police Security Services

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento Police Department (SPD) has provided contract public safety services to Kaiser Foundation Hospitals (Hospital) since 1993 (Resolution No. 1993-0714). Most recently, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2012-0411, Motion No. 2013-0325, Resolution No. 2015-0006, and Resolution No. 2017-0018 to continue public safety services for Kaiser.
- B. City Agreement No. 2017-0176 with Kaiser Foundation Hospitals to provide Police Officer security services expired on December 31, 2018.
- C. The SPD and the Hospital have negotiated a new agreement to provide safety and security services within the hospital and to continue the efforts of an existing comprehensive neighborhood policing program within the area encompassed by Bruceville Road, east and west sides of Valley Hi Drive and Wyndham Drive, which includes the Hospital, retail merchants on Wyndham Drive; and the Crossing at Wyndham Apartments, and Furniture USA.
- D. The Hospital will fund two Full Time Equivalent (FTE) sworn Police Officers for a two-year period beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$672,896.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Kaiser Foundation Hospitals to provide police security services in an amount not to exceed \$672,896 through December 31, 2020.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to maintain two FTE Police Officer positions previously authorized by Resolution No. 1993-0714 and most recently maintained by Resolution No. 2017-0018.
