

MINUTES OF CIVIL SERVICE BOARD  
CITY OF SACRAMENTO  
SPECIAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 25, 1973

The special meeting of the Civil Service Board was convened to conduct the hearing for Officer Jimmy Fairbanks concerning his discharge from the Police Department, effective August 28, 1973.

Present: James Alexander, Wilfred Street, Joseph Yew.  
Absent: Frank Reynoso, Marion Woods.

Among others present were: Appellant Jimmy Fairbanks; Attorney Richard Brown representing the City; Attorney Thomas Haas as advisor to the Board; Sgt. Fred Arthur; Capt. Carroll Johnson; Lt. Pat Houghton; and Sgt. O. Solorgano.

Officer Fairbanks had filed his request for hearing to appeal his discharge from the Police Department on August 29; the Board, at its meeting of September 4, granted his request and set the hearing for this date.


Officer Fairbanks appeared before the Board and requested a continuance due to his inability to have representation at this meeting. Officer Fairbanks stated that he would be represented by Mr. David Simmons, but that Mr. Simmons had not yet been able to meet with the Sacramento Police Officers Association Board of Directors concerning payment for his services in defending Officer Fairbanks.

Mr. Danielson informed the Board that the Personnel Department had received a call from Mr. Simmons on the morning of September 25 stating that he would not be representing Officer Fairbanks.

Following further discussion, it was moved by Mr. Street to reschedule Officer Fairbanks' hearing for 1:30 p.m., Tuesday, October 30, 1973. The motion was seconded by Mr. Yew, and carried by unanimous vote. It was further indicated by the Board members that a hearing date would not again be rescheduled for this matter.
