

Sacramento, California.

September 12, 1930.

The Civil Service Board of the City of Sacramento met in special session on the above date at 7:35 o'clock P. M. in their office, Room 106 City Hall, President Chenu presiding.

PRESENT: Commissioners Weisman and Chenu.
ABSENT : Commissioner Maloney.

The minutes of the regular session of August 21, 1930, were read and approved as read.

A committee appeared before the Board with reference to the establishment of the position of Inspector in the Fire Service. Manager for an installation of a counter in the Civil Service room. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu and the vote was as follows:

The Board next discussed the various positions now in the classified service and the nature of the duties of the position, also the holding of examinations for the positions.

Commissioner Weisman moved that the Secretary arrange dates for the Police, Fire, and Laborers examinations and submit them at the next meeting of the Board. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and the vote was as follows:

Commissioner Weisman moved that the present various forms of application for examination now used be correlated. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Chenu, and the vote was as follows:
