

# RESOLUTION No. 371

Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the Standard Specifications for the Improvement of Streets and Alleys and for the Construction of Sewers in the City of Sacramento, adopted by the City Council on December 21 1922, be, and the same are hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be known as Section 11a, which said section shall be in the words and figures following:

"SECTION 11a. PUBLIC LIABILITY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE.

The City of Sacramento shall not be responsible for damage or loss to the work or site, or other property, or for the injury or loss of life to persons employed, or to the public.

The Contractor shall take out and pay for Public Liability and Property Damage insurance, and a Contractor's Protective Insurance, protecting himself against the liability imposed by law for injuries or death sustained or suffered by the public or damage to the property of the public by reason of the work carried on under this contract. Public Liability and Contractor's Protective Insurance shall be for limits of \$10,000.00 and \$30,000.00, and Property Damage shall be for limit of \$10,000.00. This insurance shall be placed in a company satisfactory to the City of Sacramento, and three (3) copies of Certificate of Insurance shall be furnished to the City at the time the contract is signed. This Certificate of Insurance shall set forth the fact that the policy has been endorsed as follows: 'This policy is not subject to cancellation or to a reduction in coverage until five (5) days after receipt of notice of cancellation or reduction in coverage by the Controller of the City of Sacramento'.

The Contractor shall also take out and pay for Owner's Protective Liability and Property Damage Insurance, policy to be written in the name of the City of Sacramento, and protecting it for any claims made against it by reason of injuries or death sustained or suffered by the public or damage to the property of the public by reason of the work carried on under the contract. This insurance shall be placed in a company satisfactory to the City of Sacramento at the time of signing the contract.


Liability Insurance shall be for limits of \$10,000.00 and \$30,000.00. Property Damage Insurance shall be for a limit of \$10,000.00.

Provided, however, that the City Manager may accept such insurance in amounts less than the standard requirements set forth under this section where such standard requirements appear excessive because of the character or extent of the work to be performed by such contractor.

The Contractor shall not commence work under this contract until he has obtained all insurance required under this section and such insurance has been approved by the City.
