SUBJECT: ARTS RESOURCES GUIDE-
ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.57(n) OF THE CITY CODE

SUMMARY

This report recommends an amendment to Section 2.57(n) of the City Code relating to the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

BACKGROUND

Section 2.57(n) of the Sacramento City Code provides the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission with the authority to develop directories on art information, however, it does not allow the Commission, through the staff, to sell the directories. The staff, with Commission approval, recently completed the first publication, an Art Resources Guide. It is the intention of the Commission that the Guide and future publications approved by the Commission be available for sale to the general public. The City Code does not grant specific authority to the Commission to sell publications, therefore, the following modifications in Section 2.57(n) are recommended in the attached ordinance:

To develop, distribute, and sell ~~directories~~ publications of local (1) artists, (2) art groups, (3) spaces available for the fine and performing arts, and (4) services available to the arts.

FINANCIAL DATA




It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached ordinance amending Section 2.57(n) of the City Code relating to the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2.57(n) OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE RELATING TO THE SACRAMENTO METROPOLITAN ARTS COMMISSION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 2.57(n) of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2.57(n)

To develop, distribute, and sell publications of local (1) artists, (2) art groups, (3) spaces available for the fine and performing arts, and (4) services available to the arts.
