**SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD CONTRACT FOR REPLACEMENT  
OF THE MILLER PARK BOAT LAUNCH RAMP (PN: LJ11)**

It is recommended that the City Council authorize the contract award to P&M Cioli Landscape Construction for \$126,856 to replace the Miller Park Boat Launch Ramp.

**SUMMARY:**

This report requests Council authorization to award a contract to P&M Cioli Landscape Construction to replace the Miller Park Boat Launch Ramp.

**COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:**

There was no committee/commission action.



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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The City received a grant from the State Department of Boating and Waterways to replace the existing boat launch ramp and existing cable tied floating dock at Miller Park. The improvements to the facility will enhance service and access to the public. In 1998, the concrete pre-cast panels for the boat launch ramp were assembled. These panels will be installed in conjunction with other project elements to complete the project.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The bid award will be funded by the grant from the State Department of Boating and Waterways and funds from Lighting and Landscaping PN: LK96.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The City's Environmental Services Division prepared a Negative Declaration for the project and released that document for public review. One comment was received during this time. The comment was from the State Lands Commission, which indicated the City needed to secure a dredging permit for the project. The City renewed its permit and it is now current for this project.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**


Improvements to the boat launch ramp facility at Miller Park are consistent with Council's goal of improving customer service and public access to the river.

**ESBD CONSIDERATIONS:**

Staff worked with the State Department of Boating and Waterways to identify potential contractors for the project. Thirteen contractors were invited to respond to the informal bid solicitation. Only one contractor submitted a bid. This bidder is certified by the City's Office of Small Business Development Emerging and Small Business Program.




