Honorable Members in Session:

SUBJECT: Resolution Approving New Standard Specifications

SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's office has prepared new and revised Standard Specifications for use in public works construction and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The existing Standard Specifications were adopted by the City Council in 1967. Since that time there have been changes made in testing procedures, new construction materials have been accepted for use, new construction methods are being used and new and revised Federal, State and local laws have come into being that affect public works construction. The new Standard Specifications reflect these changes.

The new Standard Specifications have been reviewed by the Associated General Contractors of California, Inc., the Building Industry Association of Superior California, Granite Construction Co., and Teichert Construction.

With respect to changes in a project, the new Standard Specification sections are as follows:

Section 5-10 in the existing Standard Specifications dealing with the right to make alterations has been eliminated from the new Standard Specifications.

FINANCIAL:

It is estimated that printing of the new Standard Specifications will cost approximately \$8,000.00. This will cover an initial distribution to City Departments, private engineering firms, and contractors and several years supply of extra copies. Nine Thousand dollars has been approved in the City Engineer's Operating Budget in the 1980/81 budget for printing and binding of the new Standard Specifications.

It is proposed to recover the printing costs by charging a fee of \$4.50, including tax, per copy.

RECOMMENDATION:



RESOLUTION APPROVING ADOPTION OF NEW AND
REVISED STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, the City Council is desirous of adopting new and revised Standard Specifications and of discontinuing the use of previously adopted and amended Standard Specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the Standard Specifications in the form hereto appended shall be adopted as the Standard Specifications for public works construction of the City of Sacramento, provided, however, that:

1. The new Standard Specifications shall not be effective on any contracts made under Division 7 of the Streets and Highway Code of the State of California if the Resolution of Intention under such proceedings was adopted prior to May 1, 1981.
2. That the previously adopted Standard Specifications and amendments shall be used on any contract made under Division 7 of said code, provided that the Resolution of Intention was adopted prior to May 7, 1981.
3. That contracts made under Division 7 of said code shall use the newly adopted Standard Specification if the Resolution of Intention for such work shall have been adopted on or after May 1, 1981.
4. That in order to allow due time for printing and distribution to the construction and building industry, consulting engineers, architects, and other local government agencies, that public works contracts other than those under Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code shall use the new Standard Specifications if the Plans, Specifications and Special Provisions shall have been approved on or after May 1, 1981.

5. That all public works contracts presently in effect shall be in no way affected by the adoption of new Standard Specifications.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that:

1. The newly adopted Standard Specifications be printed and bound.

2. That in order to recover reasonable costs of printing, the City Fee and Charge Report, Page 60(a) be amended to include a price of \$4.50, including tax, be charged per copy of said Standard Specifications.
