**Title: Contract: 2007 City Street Overlay – Ramona Avenue Project (PN: RM71)**

**Location/Council District:** Ramona Avenue between Cucamonga Avenue and Power Inn Road. Location map – Exhibit A of Resolution. (District 6)

**Recommendation:** Adopt a **Resolution:** 1) approving plans and specifications for the 2007 City Street Overlay - Ramona Avenue Project (PN: RM71); 2) awarding the construction contract to Martin Brothers Construction for an amount not to exceed \$134,755; and 3) authorizing the City Manager to execute the contract with Martin Brothers Construction.

### **Description/Analysis**

**Issue:** This project will place a rubberized asphalt concrete overlay on Ramona Avenue between Cucamonga Avenue and Power Inn Road. Bids have been received for the 2007 City Street Overlay - Ramona Avenue Project. City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding the construction contract.


**Policy Considerations:** This action requested herein is consistent with the Sacramento City Code, Title 3 and with the City of Sacramento Strategic Plan goals of improving and expanding public safety.


**Environmental Considerations:** The Development Services Department, Environmental Planning Services Division has reviewed the proposed action and determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c) of the CEQA Guidelines. Class 1, Section 15301(c) consists of the maintenance, repair or minor alteration of existing highways, streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters and similar facilities including road grading for the purpose of public safety.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** Martin Brothers Construction is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Project funding is sufficient to award the contract.


**Financial Considerations:** As of July 31, 2007, the 2007 City Street Overlay Project (PN: RM71) has an unobligated balance of \$2,154,533, which is sufficient to execute the construction contract in a total amount of \$134,755 with Martin Brothers Construction and cover staff costs for traffic signal loop modifications and remaining construction management costs.

**Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD):** The ESBD goal is 20%. To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 18 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with Emerging and Small Business Enterprise (ESBE) construction firms. The project was also announced on the City's Project Internet site at [www.cityofsacramento.org/bids](http://www.cityofsacramento.org/bids). Martin Brothers Construction has achieved 20% ESBE participation.

- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract with Martin Brothers Construction.

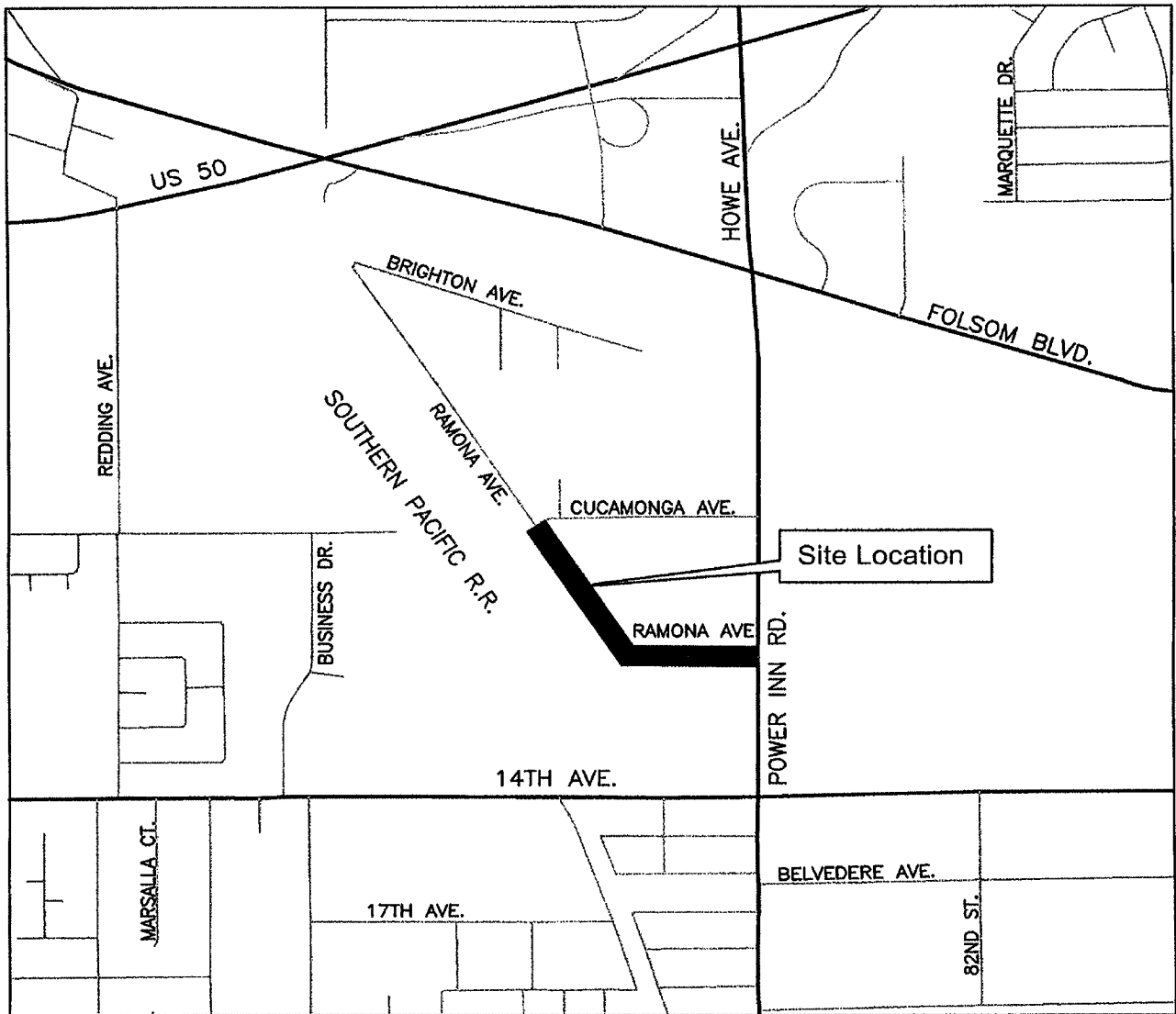
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Exhibit A: Map of 2007 City Street Overlay - Ramona Avenue Project (PN: RM71)
