SUBJECT: ANGLE PARKING

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

N Street from 2nd to 3rd Streets and 2nd Street from N to O Streets. Council District 1

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution to place angle parking on a portion of 2nd Street and N Street.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends changing the existing parallel parking on portions of 2nd Street and N Street to angle parking. This area is regulated with all day parking meters (10-hours) and is filled to capacity early each morning. Implementing angle parking will increase the parking supply by eighteen spaces. The additional parking spaces will increase parking meter revenues by \$11,000 annually.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The streets around Crocker Park have a variety of parking regulations to serve both long and short term parkers. Short term street parking is available adjacent to the Crocker Art Museum and two parking lots provide museum visitors with longer term parking. City parking Lot X has one hundred eighty parking spaces for monthly and all day use. Additional all day metered parking is provided on the street.

- The east side of 2nd Street and the south side of N Street are most suited for angle parking.
- Traffic volumes are light.
- Vehicles traveling on these streets are generally those entering or exiting the parking lots or searching for street parking.
- It is estimated that approximately eighteen additional street parking spaces can be provided with angle parking.
- The bicycle coordinator was contacted and is supportive of the change in parking.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement angle parking along this portion of 2nd Street and N Street is estimated to be \$2,500. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings Operating budget. It is estimated that there will be \$11,000 annually in additional parking meter revenue.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:


This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of sound fiscal management. It is consistent with existing cost recovery policies and procedures and will generate additional parking meter revenue. It is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.07.124 which permits the installation of angle parking on streets described in resolutions adopted by the City Council.





RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING ANGLE PARKING

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 25.07.124 of the Sacramento City Code, when markings have been placed on the pavement indicating angle parking, no person shall park any vehicle contrary to such markings on any street described in a resolution adopted by the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:

The following streets shall be regulated by angle parking:

- 2nd Street, east side, from N to O Streets
- N Street, south side, from 2nd to 3rd Streets

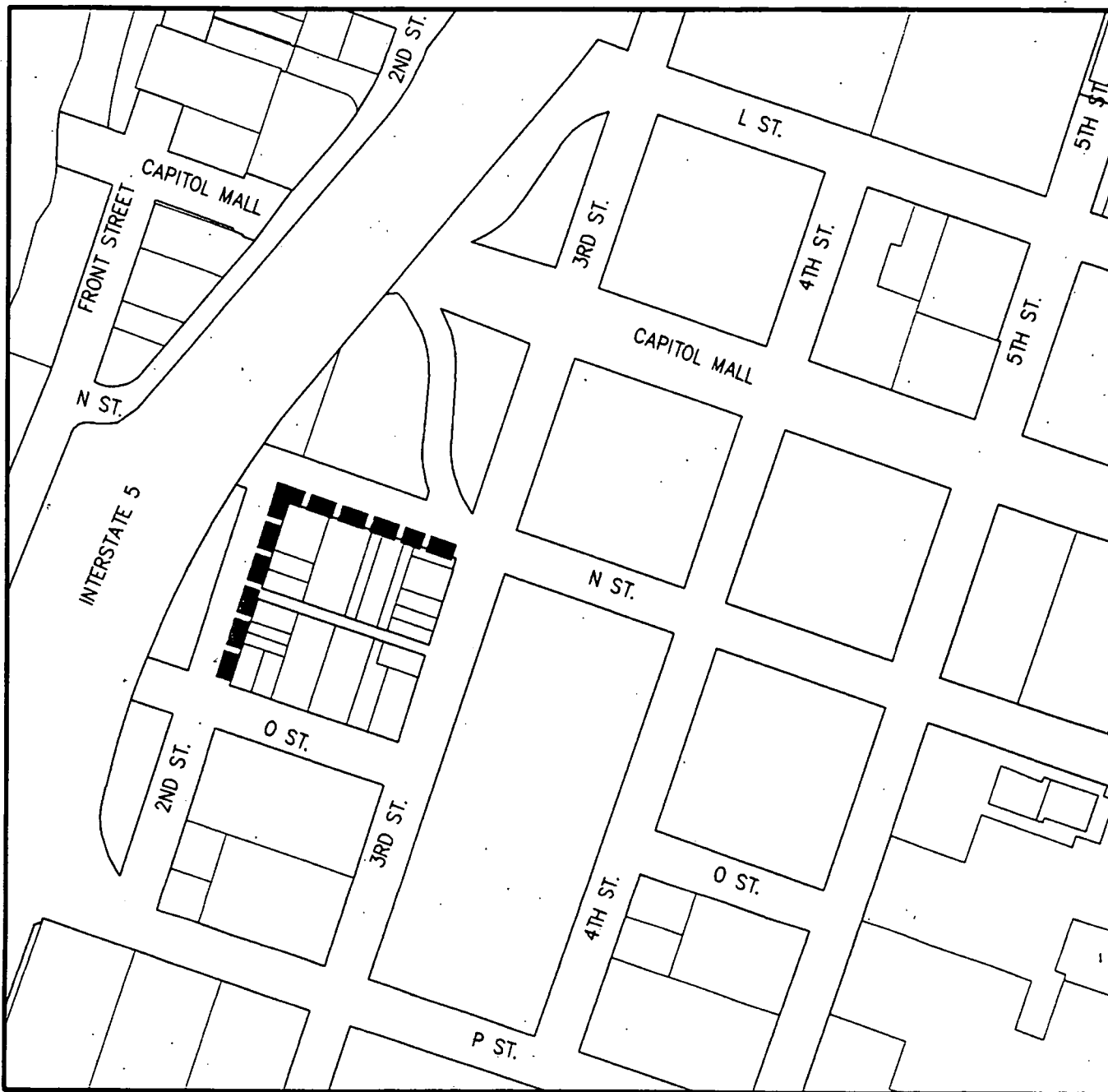
