**SUMMARY:**

This report provides a brief description of the 50 MIS, its purpose, findings, and the issues relevant to the City. Council is being asked to discuss the MIS and approve a resolution of either support or non-support for the MIS and its findings.

**BACKGROUND:**

Over three years ago, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) began a process to discuss, analyze, and build consensus about future transportation improvements in the U.S. 50 Corridor. The 27-mile long corridor links downtown Sacramento with the counties of Sacramento and El Dorado. The process included the development of a Major Investment Study for the corridor.
