

ORDINANCE NO. 1185, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING OUT OF THE REVENUES OF THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1946, THE AMOUNTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY BASED ON THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 1946, SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER AND MAKING THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:


SECTION 1: There is hereby appropriated out of the available funds not heretofore appropriated, the following sum:

The sum of \$3,902.66, balance necessary for the construction of sidewalks, parking area, gas and electrical service for the Callahan Housing Project at South Side Park in the City of Sacramento.


SECTION 2: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately; such emergency being that the immediate appropriation of this money is necessary to carry on the functions of the City of Sacramento Government.
