

ORDINANCE NO. 2005, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 481, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED AUGUST 7, 1930, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND," BY ADDING TWO NEW SECTIONS THERETO TO BE NUMBERED 11A AND 11B.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 481, Fourth Series, passed August 7, 1930, is hereby amended by adding two new sections thereto to be numbered Section 11A and Section 11B, to read as follows:

Section 11A. In accordance with the provisions of Section 11611 of the Business and Professions Code of California, the Council hereby establishes the following standards with respect to improvement of streets to be dedicated:

- (a) Layout of streets, widths of streets, and similar design criteria of the streets shall be established by City Ordinance.
- (b) Construction and materials used shall be in accordance with the STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS of the City of Sacramento, adopted by the City Council by Resolution No. 139, dated July 17, 1952.
- (c) Pavement shall be asphaltic Concrete as specified in the said STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS and shall not be less than five and one-half inches (5½") in thickness.

Section 11B. It is hereby established that all streets to be dedicated shall be improved to the standards above set forth and it is further established that the procedures set forth in Section 11612 of the Business and Professions Code of California, for the guarantee of such improvement, are hereby adopted, and any bond or deposit securing the agreement, as provided by said Section 11612, shall also be conditioned that the proposed street improvement be commenced within one year and thereafter prosecuted diligently to completion.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be published once

in the "SACRAMENTO UNION," a newspaper of general circulation and the official newspaper of the City of Sacramento and the ordinance shall be effective 30 days from and after its passage.
