SUBJECT: Preferential Parking Program Funding for the U.C. Medical Center Area and Amendments to the City's Preferential Parking Program Ordinance.

SUMMARY

This report recommends funding for implementation of the Preferential Parking Program for the U.C. Medical Center area. The program for this area was tentatively approved by the Council in November 1979. This report also recommends amendments to the City's Preferential Parking Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In November 1979, the City Council adopted a Resolution establishing a preferential Parking Program for the U.C. Medical Center area. The implementation of the program was contingent upon the receipt of a final petition representing over 50% of the dwelling units within the area.

In March 1980, the Traffic Engineer received the final petition, representing 57% of the dwelling units in the area boundaries as supporting this program.

The segment on T Street between 39th Street and 44th Street has been excluded from the program resolution because many of those residents had shown opposition to the program. However, since the adoption of the Resolution in November, the Traffic Engineer has received input from the residents on those blocks, some of whom now are showing support for the program and others who are against the program. Considering the outcome to date, we are recommending the program be implemented as approved by the Council in November 1979. Various changes as needed will be made once we have had some experience with the program.

The Judicial Counsel of the Municipal Court has recommended certain changes in the City's Preferential Parking Ordinance. An Ordinance for these amendments is attached.

FINANCIAL DATA

In November 1978, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 4177 to institute a Preferential Parking Permit Program. At that time, \$40,135 was appropriated for the cost of personnel, equipment, and supplies to implement the program for three areas. However, no programs were implemented in the fiscal year 1978-79. Also, at that time, the Council was advised that the staff would request additional funding as needed as the program expanded.


The cost to implement the U.C. Medical Center area is estimated to be \$14,540. A Resolution appropriating this amount out of the unappropriated General Fund Balance is attached.

It is recommended that:


1. The 1979-80 fiscal year budget be amended by adopting the attached Resolution in order to fund the Preferential Parking Program in the U.C. Medical Center area.

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEERING BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1979-80 TO FUND THE PREFERENTIAL PARKING PROGRAM IN THE U.C. MEDICAL CENTER AREA

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

1. Permits and signs are required to implement the Preferential Parking Permit Program in the U.C. Medical Center area.
2. The City Budget for Fiscal Year 1979-80 is hereby amended by transferring \$14,540 from the Unappropriated General Fund Balance to the Traffic Engineering Budget, 1-01-3110-8351-4461, for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.

ORDINANCE NO. 4334 FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4155 FOURTH SERIES, SECTION 25.182, TO FURTHER DEFINE THE PENALTY PROVISIONS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, SECTION 25.182 IS AMENDED TO READ:

Sec. 25.182 Penalty Provisions.

- (a) It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Article, unless expressly provided to the contrary herein, for any person to stand or park a motor vehicle contrary to the parking regulations established pursuant hereto. Said violation shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50 as established by the Municipal Court;
- (b) It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Article for a person to falsely represent himself as eligible for a parking permit or to furnish false information in an application therefor to the Traffic Engineering Office. Said violation shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both;
- (c) It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Article for a person holding a valid parking permit issued pursuant hereto to permit the use or display of such permit on a motor vehicle other than that for which the permit is issued. Such conduct shall constitute an unlawful act and violation of this article both by the person holding the valid parking permit and the person who so uses or displays the permit on a motor vehicle other than that for which it is issued. Said violation shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$50 as established by the Municipal Court;
- (d) It shall be unlawful and a violation of this Article for a person to copy, produce or otherwise bring into existence a facsimile or counterfeit parking permit in order to evade parking regulations applicable in a residential permit parking area. Upon conviction thereof, a person shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or be imprisoned for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both.
