**WHEREAS**, public safety for the citizens of our community is of the utmost priority; and



**WHEREAS**, Law Enforcement Officers work in partnership with the community to protect life and property, solve neighborhood problems, and enhance the quality of life in our City; and


**WHEREAS**, Law Enforcement Officers bear the public trust and dedicate themselves to the protection of the safety and rights of the citizens of the community.






