APPROVING THE REVISED MASTER PLAN FOR MARSHALL PARK

BACKGROUND

- A. "Marshall Park" is a 3.05-acre neighborhood park located at J Street and 28th Street. To meet current residents' needs, an update of the master plan was requested. The Marshall Park master plan revision was reviewed and supported by the Parks and Recreation Commission on January 4, 2007.
- B. The Environmental Services Manager has reviewed the project for compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.
- C. Long-term designs of public facilities are reviewed and approved by City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The revised master plan for Marshall Park is approved.


