

## RESOLUTION NO. 2006-293

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 4, 2006

### APPROVING THE USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR UEDA PARKWAY PHASE I, CIP HB16; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE USE AGREEMENT.

#### BACKGROUND:

- A. The Ueda Parkway is an important part of a regional trail system that offers both recreation and commuter opportunities. The Ueda Parkway consists of approximately 12.5 miles of paved recreation trails that are mostly on the crown of levees; Phase I will be from Main Avenue to West El Camino Avenue.
- B. The County of Sacramento currently owns recreation parcel easements where Phase I of the Ueda Parkway will be located. The County has agreed to let the City of Sacramento use their real estate interests through a use agreement.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Approves the Use Agreement between the City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento for Ueda Parkway Phase I, CIP HB16.
- Section 2. Authorizes the City Manager to execute the Use Agreement.
