Adopted by The Sacramento City Council on date of

May 14, 1948

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF SACRAMENTO:

WHEREAS, Pacific Transfer Company of  
Sacramento with headquarters at 216 - 15th Street is  
now operating a fleet of trucks to render temporary  
freight service from Sacramento to Redding, via  
Marysville and Chico; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Transfer Company has  
filed an application with the Public Utilities Com-  
mission of the State of California to be granted the  
rights of a common carrier in this territory; and


WHEREAS, Pacific Transfer Company is
