**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE LAND  
PARK/SACRAMENTO CITY COLLEGE RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Argail Way, both sides from Babich Avenue to Freeport Blvd. Council District 4

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution modifying parking regulations on Argail Way, both sides from Babich Avenue to Freeport Blvd into the Land Park/Sacramento City College residential permit parking area.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends modifying parking regulations on Argail Way, both sides from Babich Avenue to Freeport Blvd into the Land Park/Sacramento City College residential permit parking area (Exhibit A). Modifying the parking regulations on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by Sacramento City College students and nearby businesses.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The Land Park/Sacramento City College residential permit parking area was established in August 1990.
- Streets within the permit parking area have either one or two-hour parking time limits.
- Residents on Argail Way submitted a petition requesting to modify the existing one-hour permit parking time limit to no parking except with permit.
- Residents and their guests will be exempt from the parking restriction when the proper permit is displayed.
- A letter was sent to all residents that will be impacted by the change, which outlined the request and asked for comments.
- There was no opposition to the proposal.

#### **FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended modified parking regulation is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking & Animal Care Services operating budget.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines

#### **POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This recommendation is consistent with the City Council priority of neighborhood revitalization and enhancement.

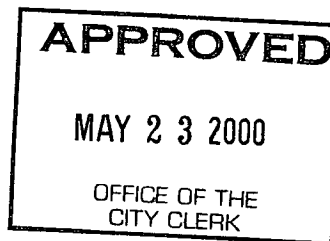
