SUBJECT: Rejection of Bids and Readvertisement of Bids for the
Purchase of 21 Portable Radios, 5 Battery Chargers and

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Sacramento Police Department has a requirement for 21 portable radios, 5 battery chargers and 10 nickel cadmium batteries. Formal bids (Bid No. 235) were solicited and received November 13, 1979. After evaluating each of the bids, it has been determined to be in the best interest of the City to revise the specifications and re-advertise for bids for this requirement.


RECOMMENDATION
