**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT PARKING FROM 8 A.M. TO 3:30 P.M. ON A PORTION OF REDDING AVENUE**

**LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:**

Redding Avenue from San Joaquin Street north for 500 ft. Council District 6.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the attached resolution be adopted to prohibit parking 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Redding Avenue from San Joaquin Street north 500 ft.

**SUMMARY:**

This report recommends that all parking be prohibited from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Redding Avenue from San Joaquin Street north for 500 ft (Exhibit A). Regulating parking on this street will relieve the parking congestion generated by all day commuter parkers.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- Parking is currently unregulated on Redding Avenue from San Joaquin Street north.
- Residents along this portion of Redding Avenue have requested that the City prohibit parking between 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Prohibiting all parking will relieve the parking congestion caused by all day commuter parkers.

**FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulation is estimated to be \$300 for the installation of regulatory signs. Funds are available in the Street Division, Traffic Signs and Markings operating budget.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:**

The Neighborhoods, Planning and Development Services Department, Office of Environmental Affairs has reviewed the project and has determined that this project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15301(c) of the CEQA guidelines.

**POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:**



**A RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT PARKING CERTAIN HOURS**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 25.07.103 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand, or park any vehicle in a business district or on streets designated by resolutions during the days and hour indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.

**THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO THAT:**

The following street shall be regulated with no parking from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. except Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays:

- Redding Avenue, west side, from San Joaquin Street north 500 ft.
