SUBJECT: North Bruceville Road (P-8578) and Raney (P-8702) Annexations

SUMMARY

Final City action on these uninhabited annexations have been deferred pending the adoption of agreements for the exchange of property tax revenues for these areas. The City and County staffs will be meeting to discuss this matter. The staff recommends continuing this matter until January 13, 1981.


BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Pursuant to City Council policy, these two uninhabited annexations have been processed to the final stage (adoption of agreements for the exchange of property tax revenues, and resolutions ordering annexation). As the State did not enact the anticipated legislation providing for the distribution of property tax revenues when territory is annexed, the City and County staffs will be meeting to discuss this matter. The League of California Cities will be seeking legislation in the next session to establish a satisfactory distribution formula.

RECOMMENDATION

The staff recommends continuing this matter until January 13, 1981.
